



David Hayton Group was established in 1966 and today has dealerships across Cumbria and Lancashire selling new and used cars and specialist prestige cars.

We chose to work with K&S McKenzie primarily due to our long-standing relationship, but also due to the wide range of services they had available – we knew they would be able to help us see the project through to a successful completion.

When I initially approached K&S McKenzie we discussed layouts, designs and budget. I found I was able to communicate easily with Andrew and Andrew (yes, two Andrews!) from the Workshop Services team. Owing to them both being ex car mechanics, they had great knowledge and a real understanding of our industry. This meant they were able to provide excellent advice and suggestions to improve the project.

Through discussions with the Workshop Services team, I suggested multiple layouts for the workshop which they were able to advise me on in order to cherry-pick the best possible plan for moving forward. My ideas also included combining old and new equipment to utilise our existing assets where possible, helping to keep costs low after purchasing the new workshop. We planned to install an airline, oil lines, and MOT equipment and the team from K&S McKenzie suggested that the computerisation of oil dispensing systems would benefit us by improving traceability – and they were right!

Whilst the building was empty the team began installing compressors and an airline throughout the building. Airline installs were shortly followed by oil lines, with the dispensing systems designed to be entirely computer controlled as suggested. We also managed to make savings by reusing our oil tanks.





K&S McKenzie installed our new equipment in great time, allowing the manufacturers to return to calibrate and certify the lifts.

Going forwards I'll have the K&S McKenzie team back to carry out routine services on all compressors and lifts in the premises. Also, being local, the team are handy to call on in case of any breakdowns.

I found the project was completed in great time, with different installs perfectly scheduled meaning there was no time wasted waiting around. I'm highly satisfied with the quality of all installs and the manner in which the project was handled, and I fully recommend K&S McKenzie for your garage equipment, sales, service and repairs.
